It enables the identification of high-risk business relationships based on criteria consistent with the OECD Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains of Minerals from Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas, as well as with the criteria under the Joint Due Diligence Standard implemented in the KGHM's Smelter Divisions (The Copper Mark, International Lead Association, Nickel Institute and Responsible Minerals Initiative).

KGHM Polska Miedž S.A. Corporate Group adheres to the highest production standards, as well as ethics of business and business activities. We follow these protocols in the whole value creation chain, which is reflected in the Code of Ethics for KGHM Polska Miedž S.A. Corporate Group. In order to comply with the United Nations Global Compact Initiatives, KGHM confirm their commitment to compliance with the basic principles of human rights, labour standards, environmental protection and corruption counteracting, which are reflected in the Human Rights Policy adopted by KGHM Polska Miedž S.A. Moreover, we also support initiatives for responsible mining of minerals from a reas affected by armed conflicts and we have made Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) a part of our long-term strategy.
